

## **Band Boosters Meeting Minutes from November 8, 2007**

The meeting was called to order at 7pm. Minutes from the last meeting were read and approved with no changes.

### **Officer Reports**

- Mr. Holley and Mr. Barton were asked to put together a budget for the remainder of this year and to look at cost for starting up next year. Mr. Holley suggested that the pizza/cookie dough fund raiser be run through the boosters like the fruit sale. He also spoke about the cost of replacement jackets with a new design being approximately \$40,000, which would include the hat and pant replacements as needed. The county would put forth \$10,000 to help with the purchase.
- Mr. Holley also reported that next year Marching Band will be offered as a ½ credit class.
- Concessions stand Management:
  - Executive board to set prices each year.
  - Tami to bring cost and profit info to the next meeting.

### **Old Business and Committee Chair Reports**

- Sherri Williams read highlights of Executive meeting.
  - Penny Crampton reported that the checkbook was audited September 11<sup>th</sup> with no exceptions and that it was currently being audited with report to follow at the next meeting. A detailed accounting of all expenditures and funds was given to all boosters present and any questions answered as Penny reviewed this sheet.
- A. Ways and Means-Jon Schoepflin:  
Poinsettia Sales- Jon contacted Boulevard Flowers about selling Poinsettia this year but it was decided it was too late for this year but may be a good fund raiser for next year. Poinsettias will be ordered for the Winter concert and raffled off at the end of the performance.  
Rifles for Color Guard: Jon made a motion to discuss purchasing 12 rifles for use both this winter for indoor competition and for next year's performance. The cost would be \$278.35. Jim Babb seconded the motion and all approved.
- B. Concessions-Tami Schoepflin and Martha Seitz:  
Will look at forming a Management Team and sub-committees.

- C. Uniforms-Cathy Sherman:  
A breakdown was presented to the group on usage, uniform repair/replacement needs, and final cleaning. A questionnaire to be given to students about the uniforms. Next year we will set up fittings to be done during percussion camp. Mr. Holley estimated approximately 40 kids to come into the band program next year and the hopes of new uniforms.
- D. Fruit Sales-Jennelle Traylor:  
Delivery date for fruit set for Dec. 3<sup>rd</sup> at 8am. Help will be needed to unload truck and any hand dollies would be helpful.

### **New business**

- A. Winter Concert: Need volunteers to help with ticket sales and Poinsettia purchase and pick-up. Bridget Lehman and Terri Shaw volunteered to sell tickets. Tickets are \$5.
- B. Concession Stand Banner: Tami Schoepflin made a motion to discuss purchase of a banner for the concession stand. It was brought up to talk to the Pepsi people for a banner. Tami to look in to this. Kathy Edwards to check with some people she knows. Buck Shaw suggested a ply board sign, Mr. Holly to check on if we can hang one.

- C. Guidelines for Concession Stand-Tami to write a procedure for running the concession stand and bring to a later meeting.
- D. Volunteer Recruitment: Tabled for this meeting.
- E. Awards Ceremony: Jan 15<sup>th</sup>
- F. Other:
