Minutes for September 2, 2008 Meeting

The meeting was called to order at 7:08pm. Minutes from the August meeting were review and approved with no corrections

Officer Reports

Treasurer: Penny Crampton provided a detail Treasurers Report (see attachment "A"), she stated that the Bank statement for July would be dropped off tonight for auditing. Due to a likey change in the football game from Friday night to Thursday night Penny asked for pre-approval for start up cash for Concessions, Spirit Wear and 50/50 for home games. Motion may by Allen Clemmons to give approval for petty cash for start up for all home games. Martha Seitz seconded motion. Unanimous approval.

Vice President: Tom Poarch reported that the floor in the concession stand has been painted and now has a non-slip surface. He is working with Suburban Propane for our propane needs but currently we have enough to get through the Bird game. He also stated that Allen Clemmons will clean and pressure wash the grill this week.

President: Sherri Williams thanked everyone that helped with Parent Preview, we sold 98 parent band shirts that night. She would also like to send a note to Coach Williams thanking him for having the football field ready that night for the bands performance.

Martha Seitz and her volunteers were also thanked for providing lunches during band camp, there were approximately 50 sandwiches made per day and a profit of \$737.00 was made. Also thanked were the people that came out for Concession stand clean-up.

Sherri also mentioned a change in the By-laws that will move meetings from the first Thursday of each month to the 1st Tuesday of each month. This will be added to the Ballot of the Spring General Meeting. Sherri will post a list of Band Boosters meetings for the rest of the year on the band web site.

Committee Chair Reports

All County Band Night: Sherri Williams reporting for chairperson Tami Schoepflin: Event to be on Oct 6, at 6pm. Tammy is planning on having 2 concession stands. The tent concession stand will be serving pizza, chick filet etc. She will need volunteers to staff 3 shifts: 4p-6p, 6p-9p and a clean up shift. Mr. Barton to send a notice to the 10 bands (approximately 1000 students) about the time that we will start serving food so we don't run into the same problem as last year with bands arriving early.

Chaperones: Joe Lewis stated that he has gotten great response from volunteers for all events except for Sept. 18 & 19(Thursday and Friday) when the band plays for the feeder elementary schools, he still needs people for those 2 days. The time will be from 9:15a to 1:30p. Mr Holley to find out what schools we will be visiting. Joe said that the first aid kit has been restocked. He also said that he will be away for the Meadowbrook game, the Sept. 18 & 19th performance and the Hermitage Competition and that MaryAnn Mazio will cover for him during that time.



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Concessions: Ann Wilson stated that she had 18 volunteers scheduled for the Bird game. The fryers and refrigerator will be in place for that night.

Publicity-Chris Craig has volunteered to head up this committee. He will help with advertising needs for the up coming Fruit Sales.

Hospitality-Chair needed.

Ways and Means:

Tag Day: Kathy Edwards stated that Tag Day is Sept. 13th from 10a-2p. call time for the kids is 9a in the band room. We will also have a booth at Chesterfest that will sell Spirit Wear and Calendars. There will be two shift there of both parents and band members. Chic-fil-a has donated 150 coupons for the kids to redeem that day and Sonic has donated prizes for the top 2 teams.

Chic-fil-A: Kathy proposed that as a fundraiser Chic-fil-A would allow us to come in on the 1st Wednesday of each month from 4:45p to 8:15p to collect receipts which we will get 10% of and they will also have a prize wheel that people pay to spin and win prizes. Kathy would need 2 volunteers to do this. A motion was made by Allen Clemmons to accept this, it was seconded by Anne Wilson and approved by all. Kathy will also contact Cici's about a similar event.

Spirit Wear: Kathy stated we are trying to deplete current inventory and then will do pre-orders only with an order form on the band website.

Fruit Sales: Jennelle Traylor presented a proposal (See attachment "B") for the fruit sales for this year. Our selling dates will be from Oct. 20-30th, we will collect money Nov. 3-7th, no orders will be accepted after Nov. 7th. Our requested delivery date will be Dec. 1st or 2nd. There will be a slight increase in the prices this year which is the first increase in several years.

We will also be advertising in the Village News with possibly an order form in the paper but we will also give them our website so they can print off an order form plus look at information about our band and what we do. Outside orders will be dropped at our P.O. box. Student profit for this year will be added to any profit the student received last year and that money will help decrease the cost of the students spring '09' trip.

50/50: MaryAnn Mazio to head this committee. She will be contacting Volunteers for this committee for all home games.

Directors Announcements:

Mr. Holley stated that he expected there to be a change in the football game schedule for Friday night due to expected weather-information on band website. He also relayed to us



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that the tops for the guard uniforms were on back order so they would wear something different for the first game.

Addendum from last meeting: there will be a decrease in the bus amounts for this year. During All County band night, the Athletic boosters will be also running their concession stand.

Mr. Holley stated that he has contacted the uniform people and that they will come down to make up a sketch for the new uniforms. DeMoulin's will be designing the uniforms and they also said that the best time to order uniforms would be between Sept. 1st to March 1st.

The meeting was adjourned at 8:55p.

1. Selling date:
