

Thomas Dale Band Booster Meeting Minutes from 8-10-06

Meeting was called to order by Kevin DeChaine at 7:05 p.m.

June meeting minutes were reviewed and approved.

Treasurer's Report: There is \$7913.00 in the account.

Old Business:

Tag Day: Scheduled for September 16. Chairperson is Cathy Edwards

Fruit Sale: This is our largest fundraiser and the only one that significantly contributes to the spring trip. Discussed discontinuing other fundraisers. A vote will be held at the next boosters meeting on this issue.

Parent Preview Night: Discussed whether we would have a full pot luck dinner or if the boosters would supply dinner. The consensus was that a booster supplied dinner, as we did last year, is the best thing to do. Kevin DeChaine will call Beth Webber to get an OK on using those funds. We will be handing out a packet of information on the boosters and committees as people come in. Each committee chair needs to get their information to Kevin DeChaine (kdechaine@comcast.net) by August 18 to be included in the packet. Cliff Cole is sending out a template for us to use. Make sure to include your contact information on your template. We will have tables set up per committee for Q&A, sign up and general information.

Concessions: John Hanchak has found a grill for the satellite stand that sells for \$750. We need to see about getting those funds approved. Kevin and John have repaired the main grill. Propane storage is a problem. There are full and partially used tanks in the concession stand and they must be removed prior to the fire marshal's inspection. We also discussed whether or not we want to use a propane exchange this year. Kevin is going to call Ferrell gas to see what kind of discount we may be able to get from them on a refill service. We have set up an account with Pepsi now. They will deliver our product and provide us w/ coolers. No more ice buckets in the stand! We will still need some ice for the satellite.

Uniform Fitting: Kathy Sherman will be doing this again this year. She has some volunteers but could use more. Especially when the uniforms return from the dry cleaners.

Knight Club/Game Night/Silent Auction: We discussed whether or not to bring this back. We did not do it last year because it was labor intensive and brought

in little revenue. We are going to include information on this event in the parent preview packet and solicit a chair person. If we can get a chair person, then we will revisit this event.

Photography: This is now a committee. Cliff Cole is the chair. He discussed the option of having volunteers to take more pictures and getting game passes for them. Discussed having more coverage by Chester Village News.
