#### Old Business

Color Guard Fundraiser status is not known yet.

Director's Tower: An email will be going out to the parents to see if there is interest in building the tower with volunteers.

All the sodas were sold at the PreFestival Concert. Remaining bottles of water are safe to use next football season and are in storage.

#### New Business

All-District Lunches catered by Martha Sietz was a great success. 360 lunches were served each day. After all costs were covered, \$1600 was donated to the Band Boosters. This \$1600 is not considered a profit per Mr. Holley, as it was a donation from a parent (who happens to be a local caterer).

Jennifer Crowder has resigned as secretary and concessions chair. Tami Schoepflin to take over for secretary position.

ByLaws: Jim Babb, Monica Cole, Bridget Lehman, Buck and Terry Shaw and Jon Schoepflin met February 25 to revise the bylaws. Monica gave us an update: there will need to be a lot more work done; more meetings to accomplish the goal of revising the existing language to represent our band. If we submit the bylaws as they stand now; any corrections will result in an additional payment of the \$800 to \$1000 submission fee. Monica reported that the plan is to have parents vote on the bylaws during August 2007 Parent Preview night.

Kevin proposed a Band Camp Committee to help with the collection of band camp fees on a timely basis.

Kevin proposed that catering lunches for band camp may be an idea as a service to the attendees who do not bring lunch.

Kevin suggested that the band boosters think about a date for our pot luck dinner at either the May or June Booster Meeting.

#### Director's Report:

- 1) District Festival: Mr Holley reported that the bands played very well overall. The band directors were very pleased with the performances. He noted that our Freshman band played a level of music that other school's upper band levels played.

- 2) March 20<sup>th</sup> is the Parent Meeting (no students) for the Spring trip.

Spring trip performances will be held Thursday March 29<sup>th</sup> at Disney.

There will be 4 buses transporting students and chaperones. Because of the cost of the additional (4<sup>th</sup>) bus required; the Arabian Nights event is going to be cancelled.
